“HORIZONTAL WET & CIRCUIT VENTING”

WHAT YOU WILL LEARN:

The new 2016 California Plumbing Code includes new requirements for horizontal wet venting that deal with provisions detailing how to plumb a typical residential bathroom with minimal venting and still comply with the Code. In addition, a new section dealing with “circuit” venting has been included to allow circuit venting numerous plumbing fixtures with also minimal venting requirements. As with any new provisions, there could be confusion and uncertainty on what would be allowed and what would not. This class will explain in details these two sets of new provisions and provide examples and figures to allow for discussion and explanation.
